

Charitable Purpose Project: a targeted outreach program, using case management, educational and transportation services to increase community access to the University of Maryland's dental clinic in Perryville;

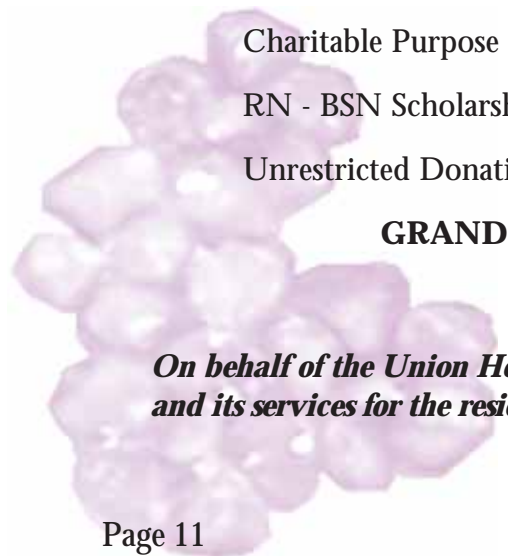

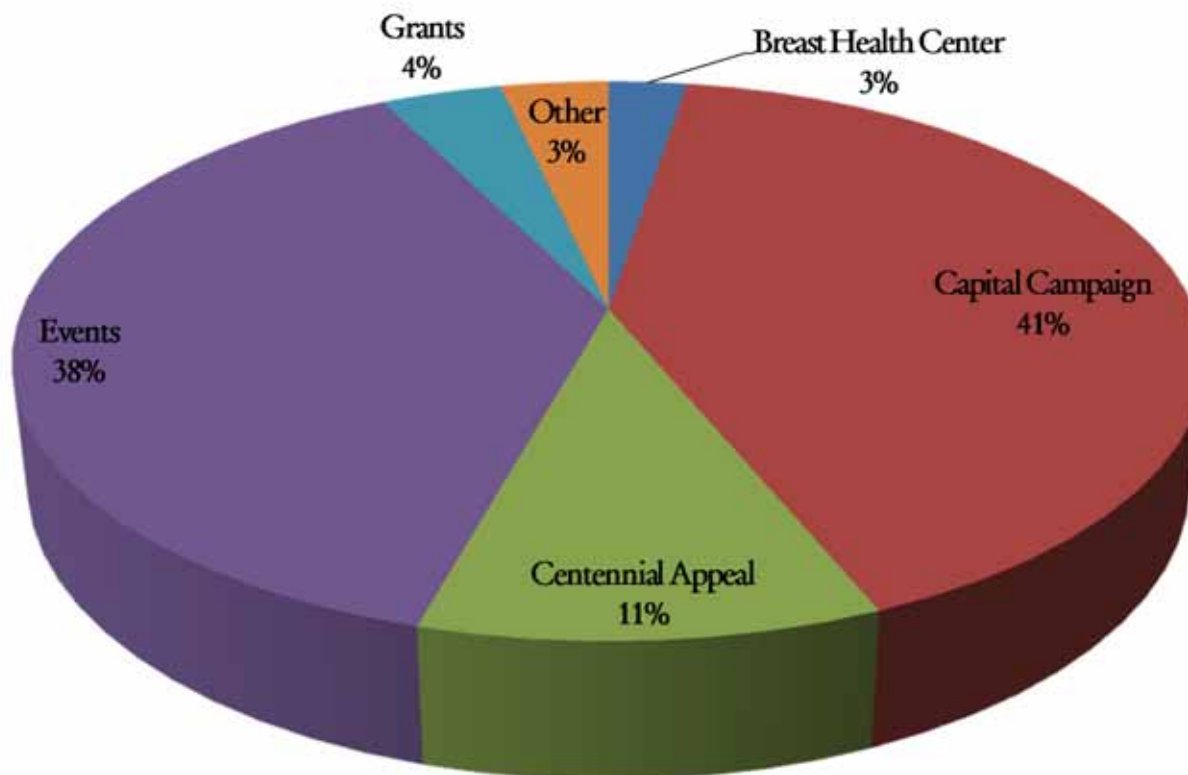

January 1, 2008 - December 31, 2008



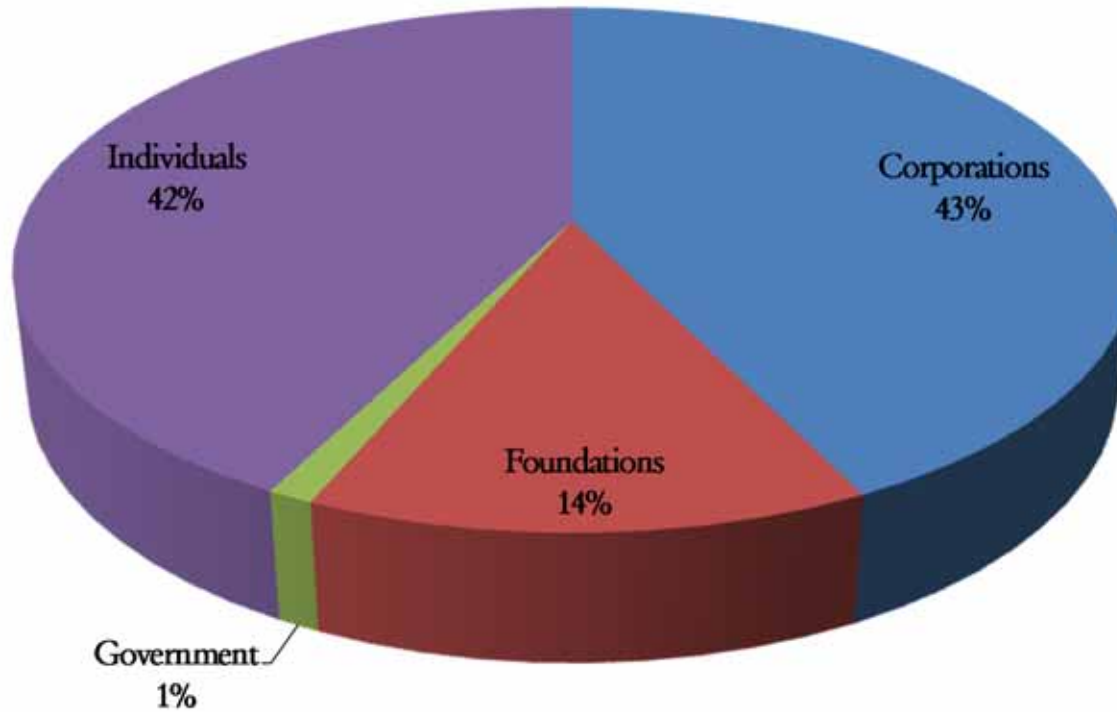

Volunteer Services

During 2008, Union Hospital's combined 300-member Volunteer/Auxiliary Team provided over 50,000 hours of service in over 30 positions throughout the hospital.
